





Athens, Greece / Day 1

Meet fellow guests, your expert trip leaders and dedicated guest services staff for a festive welcome dinner. We depart early the next day for Rwanda. *Hotel Grande Bretagne and King George*

Volcanoes National Park or Kigali, Rwanda / Days 2 – 4

Land in Kigali and depart directly for three nights in the verdant mountains of Volcanoes National Park. Accompanied by an expert naturalist guide, hike through beautiful bamboo forests to get up close with a family of gorillas. *One&Only Gorilla's Nest, Bisate Lodge, Amakoro Songa Lodge*

Alternate: Opt to spend three nights in Kigali instead of gorilla trekking in the mountains. In addition to the Kigali Genocide Memorial, visit the Akilah Institute, an inspiring vocational training program for young women. Choose to take a helicopter ride over the Virunga Mountains, a forested volcanic landscape dotted with picturesque lakes. *Kigali Marriott Hotel*

Cape Town, South Africa / Days 5 – 7

Surrounded by Atlantic surf and world-renowned vineyards, Cape Town is a stylish outpost at the edge of the earth. Ride a cable car for majestic vistas from Table Mountain. Fly by helicopter to the Cape of Good Hope, taking in the soaring cliffs and dramatic coastal views. *Belmond Mount Nelson Hotel*

Walvis Bay, Namibia / Days 8 – 9

A haven for nature lovers, Walvis Bay offers several outdoor options. Spot playful seals on a Walvis Bay cruise and spy rare pelicans and flamingos in the natural lagoon. Go flightseeing and soar over the windswept dunes of the Diamond Coast. *Strand Hotel Swakopmund*

Okavango Delta, Botswana / Days 10 – 11

The Okavango Delta is a wetland oasis offering a different experience than the vast, dry vistas common on most East Africa safaris. Photograph beautiful big game including white rhino, herds of giraffe, and elephants on a water safari. *Mombo Camp, and Beyond Sandibe Okavango Safari Lodge or Vumbura Plains*

Victoria Falls, Zambia / Day 12

The Kololo tribe called Victoria Falls the "smoke that thunders." A UNESCO World Heritage site, these spectacular falls plunge thunderously down a series of gorges and create a rainbow mist that can be seen from more than 12 miles away. *Royal Livingstone Hotel*

Madagascar / Days 13 – 15

Madagascar is one of the most biodiverse places on Earth with some 80 percent of its flora and fauna endemic to the island. After landing, depart on the four-hour drive to Andasibe–Mantadia National Park, a dense

rain forest home to the largest species of lemur. Spend two nights at the park before returning to Antananarivo for your final evening. *Andasibe Hotel or Vakona Forest Lodge, Andasibe–Mantadia National Park and Relais des Plateaux, Antananarivo*

Masai Mara, Kenya / Days 16 – 18

The Mara, as this stunning game reserve is known, forms the northernmost limit of the greater Serengeti-Mara ecosystem. An abundance of Africa's game roams over the vast grasslands. Embark on a safari drives to discover an astonishing concentration of animal life, including wildebeests, giraffes, elephants, lions, and black rhinos, as well as more than 500 species of birds. *Angama Mara*

Athens, Greece / Days 19 – 20

Fly to Athens for a final gala dinner and catch your independent flight home the following day. *Hotel Grande Bretagne and King George*
