



BARCELONA, SPAIN

Begin your extraordinary journey in the heart of Catalonia.

Arrive in Barcelona on your independent flight and meet fellow travelers and journey staff over cocktails and dinner at the hotel. Spend the next day on your choice of excursions in Spain's second largest city.

Trace the influence of local architect Antoni Gaudí's otherworldly work as you explore several of his masterpieces. Wander through the sprawling **Parc Güell**, which he originally designed as an upper-class enclave of homes overlooking the sea. When buyers failed to materialize, however, the private estate was purchased by the city and opened as a public park. Visit lovely **Casa Batlló**, one of Gaudí's iconic buildings, and **La Pedrera**, which is now home to one of Barcelona's most active cultural centers. Cap your immersion in *modernisme* with a guided tour of the fantastic—and still unfinished—**Basilica of the Sagrada Família**.

Alternatively, experience some of Barcelona's most vibrant neighborhoods as you stroll the festive streets of **Las Ramblas**, visit the chic seaside area of **El Born** and browse the wares at **Santa Caterina Market**, a splendid refurbishment of the city's first covered food market. This evening, board your private yacht and set sail for the Costa Brava.

MAY 7

Arrive Roses, Spain: 8:00am  Depart Roses, Spain: 6:00pm

ROSES AND COSTA BRAVA, SPAIN

Embark on a surrealist adventure or explore the Costa Brava by kayak or bike.

This morning, arrive in the beautiful port city of **Roses**, which was founded by Greek colonists more than 2,500 years ago. Upon disembarkation, set off on your selected excursion.

Visit the fantastic **Theatre-Museum of Salvador Dalí** in the nearby town of Figueres. Conceived of and designed by the artist himself, the museum is home to some of Dalí's most famous works as well as a sampling from every period of the great surrealist's career. Considered to be Dalí's last great masterpiece, the museum provides a unique window into the mind of one of the art world's most original—and most mischievous—thinkers.

Alternatively, launch a **kayak** from the yacht's unique retractable marina to enjoy the cobalt waters of the Bay of Roses, or hop aboard a bike and **cycle** through the gently rolling agricultural terrain outside Roses. If you like to **snorkel**, don a mask and fins and swim through a series of natural rock pools that provide a habitat for crabs and a variety of small fish. Return to your yacht this evening for dinner.

MAY 8

Arrive Sète, France: 8:00am  Depart Sète, France: 11:59pm

SÈTE AND CARCASSONNE, FRANCE

Take a stroll through history in the South of France.

Upon arrival this morning in the seaside commune of Sète, disembark and join your guide for your selected adventure.

Travel to the university town of Montpellier to visit the **Château de Flaugergues**, an elegant villa constructed in the 17th and 18th centuries. The château—a typical “folly” built by members of the new aristocracy—features a series of elaborate gardens and a massive staircase that takes up a full third of the building. After exploring the château, enjoy a wine tasting of varietals made from local grapes, which have been grown here since the region was a Roman colony.

Or explore the medieval walled city of **Aigues-Mortes** on a guided tour that includes such striking landmarks as the expansive ramparts, the Gothic Church of Notre Dame des Sablons and the Tower of Constance, which was built to protect the town, but was eventually turned into an infamous jail in which Louis XIV imprisoned many Protestant dissidents.

Alternatively, stay in Sète and take a **gourmet walking tour** of this lovely city, which is crisscrossed by canals and linked by 12 bridges. Stop to see the fishing boats and La Criée, the famous seafood auction house that sells the fresh catch of small-scale fishing vessels that ply the waters of the Mediterranean. If you're feeling adventurous, embark on a **cycling excursion**. Enjoy an evening in town to sample the local shellfish, take a stroll on the canal quays and soak up the atmosphere of this unspoiled jewel of the Mediterranean.

MAY 9

Arrive Cassis, France: 8:00am  Depart Cassis, France: 7:00pm

CASSIS AND PROVENCE, FRANCE

Immerse yourself in the cultural pleasures of Provence.

First developed more than 2,000 years ago, Cassis continues to entice travelers with its crisp, floral white wines, luxuriant vineyards and charming waterfront. As you sail into the Côte d'Azur port, admire the rocky cliffs and *calanques* of the coast.

Disembark and set off on a lovely drive through bucolic scenery on your way to **Aix-en-Provence**, the elegant capital of the region. Stroll the narrow cobblestone lanes of the old town, walk under the graceful plane trees of the **Cours Mirabeau** and spot the famous Deux Garçons café, which was frequented by the likes of Paul Cézanne and Ernest Hemingway. Then, stop to visit the **Cathedral of the Holy Savior**, which was built on the site of a Roman forum. Don't miss the beautiful 16th-century tapestries on the interior of the nave, or the cathedral's tranquil Romanesque cloisters. Enjoy some time to sip a *café au lait*, savor the leisurely pace of life in Provence and browse the stylish boutiques before returning to the harbor.

After your adventure, head back to your yacht—gently bobbing in the harbor—for cocktails at The Top of the Yacht Bar and a gourmet dinner under the stars.

MAY 10

Arrive Portofino, Italy: 8:00am  Depart Portofino, Italy: 1:00am

PORTOFINO, ITALY

Spend a glorious day in this quintessential Italian Riviera resort.

Arrive this morning in the half-moon-shaped seaside village of Portofino, its pastel houses lining the shores of the harbor. Once a Roman colony, the city has been ruled by the English, French, Spanish and Austrians. These days, it's a hotspot for the rich and famous who anchor their mega-yachts in the harbor each summer.

Disembark and learn about the role of olive oil in Italian cuisine from the maître d'hotel of the exclusive **Belmond Hotel Splendido**, which overlooks the Portofino Harbor. Afterwards, savor a delicious lunch of Italian specialties, wine and dessert before returning to the harbor. Alternatively, meet the chef of Belmond Splendido Mare and enjoy a special private class in which you'll delve into the art and science of making a **traditional Ligurian pesto**, followed by lunch accompanied by local wine.

Or, if you like, set off on a guided hike through town and out past graceful villas, ancient vineyards and olive groves on your way to the main promenade of **Santa Margherita**. Stop for a snack at a local café and enjoy some time to explore this beautiful seaside village before returning to Portofino.

You have the evening at leisure to indulge in some of the pleasures of this classic seaside resort. Amble around the harbor, sip an *aperitivo* as the sun goes down and dine on freshly caught seafood or Ligurian specialties like *pappardelle al Portofino*, topped with shrimp or freshly caught fish baked in bay leaves.

MAY 11

Arrive Monte Carlo, Monaco: 9:00am  Depart Monte Carlo, Monaco: 1:00am

MONTE CARLO, MONACO

Live the high life in glitzy Monte Carlo.

Arrive this morning in the Principality of Monaco, a sovereign state on France's Mediterranean coast. Enjoy a full day and evening to immerse yourself in the pleasures of chic Monte Carlo.

Wander through the streets of the 14th-century **hilltop village of Eze** before entering the villa that houses the **Île de France museum**, a priceless collection of art assembled by the Baroness Béatrice Ephrussi de Rothschild. Or spend a few hours living the life of a Formula 1 driver as you take an unforgettable excursion through Eze behind the wheel of a **Ferrari**.

If you like, take to the air for a spectacular **sightseeing flight by helicopter** over the glorious Côte d'Azur. After returning to land, embark on a guided exploration of Monte Carlo's ritziest districts. Or visit the village of Eze and then ascend the **Rock of Monaco** for a walking tour of the Old City, including the **Oceanographic Museum**, the cathedral containing the **tomb of Princess Grace** and the exterior of the **Prince's Palace**. This evening, if you choose, dress to the nines, sip a martini (shaken, not stirred, of course) and play a few hands of baccarat in the **Casino de Monte-Carlo**.

MAY 12

Arrive Cannes, France: 9:00am  Depart Cannes, France: 10:00pm

CANNES, FRANCE

Discover a fortified hilltop village or create your own fragrance.

Once a tiny fishing village, Cannes is now one of the most famous cities in France. Today, embark on your choice of excursions in the French countryside.

Drive along the scenic Middle Corniche Road, through rolling hills and rich valleys, on your way to the enchanting fortified village of **St. Paul de Vence**, one of the oldest medieval towns on the French Riviera. Take a guided tour of some of the city's elegant homes and ramparts, and visit the hilltop cemetery, which is home to Russian-French painter Marc Chagall's simple white tomb. Later, enjoy some time to explore the shops, galleries and cafés on your own.

Alternatively, leave the shores of the Mediterranean and travel inland to the foothills of the Alps and Grasse, the birthplace of the French perfume industry. At the venerated **Galimard Perfumery**—established in 1747 when the Count de Galimard began to create the first fragrances for the court of Louis XV—tour the museum and the workshop to learn how perfume is created. Then, work with a Master Perfumeur to choose from more than 120 essences as you design and name your own unique fragrance.


Back in Cannes, enjoy the evening at leisure to dine and stroll the waterfront before returning to your yacht for a final night on board.





KIGALI AND VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK, RWANDA

Come face-to-face with the majestic mountain gorillas of Volcanoes National Park.

This morning, disembark the yacht in Nice and board your private jet for the flight to Rwanda.

Explore Kigali, the cultural heart of Africa's most densely populated country, and at the **Kigali Memorial Center**, learn more about the 1994 genocide, especially the survivors' stories and how Rwandans are creating an environment for unity and healing.

The next morning, depart for the verdant mountains of **Volcanoes National Park**, home of the majestic mountain gorillas and several habituated groups of golden monkeys. Nearly half of the 700 or so remaining **mountain gorillas** in the world live in the forested **Virunga Mountains** that span the countries of Rwanda, Uganda and the Democratic Republic of Congo. Mountain gorillas live in groups of up to 30 individuals led by an alpha male, known as a silverback for the gray swath of hair that stands out from the rest of his black coat. The adults spend much of their days eating roots, wild celery and tree bark, while the juveniles chase each other through the forest, climb trees and swing from branches. Accompanied by an expert naturalist guide, hike through beautiful bamboo forest to get up close with a family of gorillas. Spend an hour watching these peaceful giants munch leaves, groom each other and play in the forest.

MAY 13 - 15



ACCOMMODATIONS

KIGALI: Located on one of the city's most charming boulevards, the **Kigali Serena Hotel** provides contemporary accommodations and amenities, including a wide sundeck and beautiful swimming pool.

VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK: The guest cottages and main building of the **Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge** offer spectacular views of the volcanoes and countryside. Each cottage is made of stone and terra-cotta and features a private veranda and living room with a fireplace.

Overlooking the Virunga volcanoes and shimmering lakes, the **Virunga Lodge** offers comfortable *bandas* (bungalows) with modern amenities. The lodge uses solar panels, lanterns and candles, and its en suite bathrooms feature hot water heated by solar power.

Located on the white sand shores of Lake Kivu and nestled amid lush tropical gardens, **Lake Kivu Serena Hotel** features modern guest rooms with stunning lake views. Amenities include a luxurious swimming pool, lakeside bar and a private beach.



OKAVANGO DELTA OR KALAHARI DESERT, BOTSWANA

Spot big cats, crocodiles, hippos, elephants, giraffes and more in the wetlands of the Okavango Delta.

The **Okavango Delta** is a wetland oasis and offers a completely different experience than the vast, dry vistas common on most East African safaris. Your adventure starts immediately upon landing with a game drive on the way to your remote camp. As you drive, you may spot **lions** and **cheetahs**, as well as crocodiles and the red lechwe, an antelope that thrives in marshlands.

Over the next two days, search for **leopards, spotted hyenas, hippos, elephants, giraffes and great herds of buffalo** on early-morning and late-afternoon game drives. Return to camp each evening for a classic sundowner, taking in the grand views with refreshments in hand.

Alternate: In the **Kalahari Desert**, salt pans transform the landscape into a moon-like clay terrain where meerkats and baobab trees thrive. Trek with **Bushmen** to learn survival skills and ride a four-wheel-drive safari vehicle through the grasslands to take in the native flora and fauna of the Kalahari.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Under large, shady trees overlooking a floodplain filled with wildlife, **Mombo Camp** offers spacious en suite tents built six feet off the ground. Long verandas feature beautiful views of the northern tip of Chief's Island and the native wildlife, while two pools provide ample opportunity to relax.

Set on a lagoon in the middle of a wildlife reserve, the luxurious tents of **Kings Pool Camp** offer expansive views of the Okavango Delta. Each well-appointed tent features a private plunge pool and thatched pavilion overlooking the surrounding landscape, as well as en suite facilities.

Set in a cool forest canopy of wild palms and gnarled fig trees, **Sandibe Okavango Safari Lodge** coexists peacefully with the magnificent landscape of southern Africa. Each guest suite looks out over the golden marshes, lush palm islands and shimmering waters of the Delta.

Alternate: Refurbished to reflect traditional East African 1940s safari style, **Jack's Camp** features spacious, environmentally friendly tents with verandas overlooking the grasslands.



CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA

Explore rich history and stunning natural landscapes at the tip of Africa.

Surrounded by stunning Atlantic surf and world-renowned vineyards, Cape Town is a stylish outpost at the edge of the Earth. The city's most beloved landmark is the majestic **Table Mountain**, a flat-topped mountain that soars two-thirds of a mile above sea level. Ride a cable car to the summit and stroll along a wooden walkway to see stunning panoramic views of the city and the sea. Keep an eye out for the diminutive rock hyrax, a rodent-like creature that is the closest living relative of the modern-day elephant and manatee.

Fly by helicopter to the Cape of Good Hope, taking in the soaring cliffs and dramatic coastal views on your way to the end of the continent. Get up close and personal with the convivial **African penguin colony** among the coves of Boulders Beach. Or board a private boat for **Robben Island**, a UNESCO World Heritage site, where Nelson Mandela and other political leaders were imprisoned. Enjoy some time to stroll around the **Victoria & Alfred Waterfront** with its collection of fine restaurants, friendly pubs and international boutiques.

MAY 21 - 22

Cape Town, South Africa ✈ Marrakech, Morocco: 11h

MARRAKECH, MOROCCO

Indulge in a feast of the senses as you explore the twisting pathways of the medina.

The first imperial city of Morocco, Marrakech lies in the fertile Haouz plain at the foot of the Atlas Mountains. Massive ramparts built around 1122 surround the city, which has some of the most impressive examples of Islamic architecture in existence. An 11th-century irrigation system is still used to water the city's gardens.

Perhaps the highlight of Marrakech, **Jemaa el-Fna** square is at the heart of one of the most vibrant medinas in the world. This ancient walled quarter is filled with narrow, maze-like streets crowded with merchants, snake charmers, musicians and entertainers. In the evening, sip a sweet mint tea while gazing out over the square as the sun descends behind the surrounding mountains.

Explore the venerable **Ali Ben Youssef Medersa**, which was founded more than 400 years ago as a center of learning in the region. Admire the grand architectural lines of the **Koutoubia Mosque** and its iconic minaret. Stop periodically in the medina to visit local craftsmen plying their traditional trades of leatherwork, metalwork and jewelry. Shop for gold, carpets, clothing, art and other treasures in the souks of the old city. Stroll through the dreamlike landscapes of the **Jardin Majorelle**, arriving at the blue fountain that sits at the heart of the gardens.

Alternatively, trek into the **Atlas Mountains** to visit a Berber village. Meet the chieftain, tour traditional homes and eat a Moroccan lunch before returning to Marrakech. On your last evening in Marrakech, gather for a festive farewell dinner to commemorate your journey through the Mediterranean and Africa.



ACCOMMODATIONS

An oasis of elegant *riads* in the heart of the medina, the **Royal Mansour** is centered on a traditional tiled courtyard with a fountain. Each private *riad* has been decorated in classic Moroccan style and features a plunge pool, a solarium and lounge.
